SUMMARY OF VOCATIONAL PROGRAMS

The district offers a complete vocational program, which is open to all students. The following vocational programs are offered at the school level:

FAMILY & CONSUMER SCIENCE: FACS Essentials, Food/Nutrition, Advanced Foods, Culinary I & II, Family and Consumer Sciences Internship or Co-op, Early Childhood Development, Child Development Services 1, Child Development Services 2

BUSINESS & OFFICE: Entrepreneurship, Financial Management, Accounting and Finance Foundations, Business and Marketing Essentials, Financial Services 1, Personal Finance, Digital Literacy, Microsoft Office Specialist, Financial Management, and Business Internship or Co-op

AGRICULTURE: Principles of Agriculture, Agricultural Internship or Coop, Agriculture Construction Skills I, Ag. Structures and Design, Ag. Power and Machinery Operation, and Agriculture Employability Skills

ENGINEERING DESIGN:

Engineering 1, Engineering 2, Architectural and Civil Design, Advanced Design Applications, Engineering Capstone, Engineering Internship or Co-op.

GRAPHIC DESIGN: Intro to Media Arts, 2-D Media, Digital Imaging, Advanced Production Design, Graphic Design Internship or Co-op, Digital Literacy,

DIESEL MECHANICS: Section A - Engines, Section B - Brakes, Section C - Electrical, Section D - Suspension

OWENSBORO COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE (OCTCS) DAVIESS COUNTY CAMPUS: (programs are offered based upon the demand for specific classes) Auto Technology, Diesel Technology, Child Care Development, Health Sciences, Machine Tool, Computer Aided Drafting, and Welding

OWENSBORO COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE (OCTCS) OWENSBORO CAMPUS:

Basic Electronics, Carpentry, Health Services, Metal Fabrication, Construction Technology, Machine Tool Technology, Industrial Maintenance, Electricity, Fire Science, Air Conditioning and Drafting

All course offerings are free to the students and transportation is provided to and from the area vocational school, unless unable to schedule on a regular vocational route.

Adult Education classes are offered to individuals pursuing a GED certificate. Adult programs are offered periodically based upon the demand for specific classes.
