## FACE MASKS INSIDE SCHOOL BUILDINGS

The use of face masks by all students and staff during school hours and on school busses will be optional. School district officials will continue to evaluate the local conditions surrounding COVID-19, and will communicate any updates as they occur.

## QUARANTINE

Communication with a child's school is vitally important to keeping in-person learning a priority. Our schools will work individually with quarantined students to provide the best instruction possible, which could be remote learning utilizing Google Classroom. Any student quarantined for 5 days or more may receive instruction through our Home-Hospital Program.

## POSSIBLE SCENARIOS

### Positive for Covid-19 (With Symptoms)

- Please consult a Medical Health Professional for your date of return.
- Kentucky Dept. of Public Health recommends isolation for 10 days. If symptoms fully resolve, isolation may be shortened and end after day 5 if fever free for 24 hours.
- KDPH also recommends to wear a well-fitted mask for Days 6-10.

### Positive for Covid-19 (Without Symptoms)

- Please consult a Medical Health Professional for your date of return.
- Kentucky Dept. of Public Health recommends isolation for 5 days and may return after Day 5 if fever free for 24 hours.
- KDPH also recommends to wear a well-fitted mask for Days 6-10.

### Close Contact with Someone Diagnosed with Covid-19

- Kentucky Department of Public Health recommends monitoring symptoms for 10 days from last exposure.
- Please Contact a Medical Health Professional if symptoms arise.
