A note from the Principal:

South Hancock Families, Thank you to all of our Grandparents and family members that were able to attend our Grandparent's Lunch on Sept. 13th. We welcomed about 200 guests on that day and our students had a wonderful time seeing some of their favorite people at their school and eating lunch with them. We have another family event coming up Thursday evening, September 21st from 5:00-6:30. We will have pizza and drinks that have been generously donated by Weber's Store, and our parents will be able to visit their child's classroom to get an overview of the grade level standard work, homework expectations, etc. We hope that this is an informative night for all of our families.

I want to give a HUGE shoutout to all of our students, faculty, and families for all of the great effort that has been put forth in growing our students for success. In the past month, our school and District has been featured on an exclusive literacy panel with state and school leaders on KET. A reporter came to South and North and interviewed teachers about the work and professional development that has been completed through LETRS and IMSE, which deepen understanding of the science of reading and a multi-sensory approach to literacy. This work has empowered our staff, which has therefore empowered our students in reading and writing. Also, Mrs. Pulliam, our District Literacy Coach/Interventionist and IMSE certified educator was recently contacted by ED Week, after hearing about South's great work through the KET report, and also asked for a brief interview of staff here at South. This will be published at a later date. Lastly, we were visited on Sept. 15th and recognized by Green River Regional Education Cooperative and the Kentucky PBIS Network for implementing positive behavior intervention supports with fidelity for all students at South. Our faculty team and students have worked very hard to provide a consistent framework and supports to model, reteach, and recognize expectations that will instill confidence and positivity for students in all that we do. We continue to strive to provide a safe and positive environment for all students at South so we can build lasting relationships and academic success. 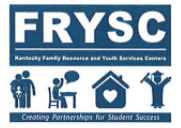

It is very important you keep this appointment. You must call in advance to cancel or reschedule if you cannot keep your appointment. Christmas application appointments will be conducted September 11th-22nd during office hours. Requirements will be explained further during the appointment.
